More activities in four days than the five last year - https://www.energyweek.fi

- More than 8,000 participants from at least 48 countries (in 2023: 7,100 visitors from 44 countries).
- On Tuesday, 13 ambassadors and a total of 19 embassy representatives attended the event.
- During the four days, participants got to hear a total of 210 speakers at 32 events or seminars. (2023: 160 presentations at 30 events)
- Matchmaking meetings took place over three days and the number of prearranged meetings continued to grow (2024: 710 meetings over three days, 2023: 550 meetings over four days)
- The number of foreign visitors also remained at the record high level of 2023
