A deep emphasis on the arts, crafts, creativity, and empathy as essential skills.



While the world is full of EdTech platforms, apps, and content, our expertise lies in what makes them truly work. We complement global technology by focusing on the critical layers that drive success.



We build democratic resilience through advanced media and Al literacy.


In an era of hybrid threats and global information warfare, we position AI literacy as a core democratic skill. Students learn to:

SEE Finland connects international collaborators with the full spectrum of Finnish educational excellence.


